### **Schools to accept new bids for girls' athletic facilities**

Higher-than-expected bids for construction of three girls' athletic buildings led Vicksburg Warren School District trustees to vote to readvertise the projects in a special meeting Thursday.

The three structures — fieldhouses for Vicksburg and Warren Central high schools and a concession stand and press box for WC's softball field — were projected to cost \$753,790, but seven construction companies submitted plans that ranged from \$924,000 to \$1,056,137. [\(More...\)](#)

### **Vicksburg Trustmark gets new president**

Former Vicksburg banker William I. "Buddy" Lewis will assume the presidency of Trustmark National Bank in Vicksburg in a series of changes that will see Jerry Hall, now president, promoted to regional executive in charge of Trustmark's Southern Community Bank Division.

Also, John Bonar has been promoted from his post as senior vice president for Trustmark here to senior credit administrator.

Before joining Trustmark in 1983, Lewis was vice president of Merchants Bank, which was subsequently sold to BancorpSouth. He has been president of the Trustmark operation in McComb since 1989.

### **Griffing, Leggett coming home to go into Hall**

**JACKSON** — Glynn Griffing has been eligible for the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame for nearly 40 years.

Turns out, it was worth the wait.

The former Ole Miss star, who was MVP of the 1963 Sugar Bowl and Senior Bowl, will get to come home to Warren County to be inducted.



The ceremony for the new class of inductees will be in Vicksburg, a few miles from where Griffing grew up and starred for Culkin Academy, on April 12.

"That will be a real treat," he said Thursday after the eight-member Class of 2002 was introduced at the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame and Museum.
