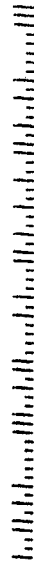

... received his dance education at the Kiev State Choreographic School and a Bachelor and a Master of Arts degree from the Kiev State University of Culture. In 1988 he began his professional career at the Kiev National Opera and Ballet Theatre, dancing numerous solo and principal roles, touring Europe, Japan, Mexico, and Canada. In 1994 Arkadiy won the Bronze Medal at the Serge Lifar International Ballet Competition in Kiev, Ukraine. Following this prestigious award, he joined the El Paso Ballet as a principal dancer, taught master classes, choreographed shows, conducted workshops for graduate students, and directed performances for various dance establishments. In 1997 Arkadiy accepted an artistic director position at Brigham Young University, UT, where he staged numerous original works and masterpieces such as *Coppelia* and *Paquita*. He has appeared throughout the US as guest artist with Corpus Christi Ballet, California Ballet, Clear Lake Metropolitan Ballet, and Dallas Metropolitan Ballet. His repertoire includes leading roles such as Tibault and Romeo in *Romeo and Juliet*, the Prince in *Cinderella*, *Franz* in *Coppelia*, Prince Ivan in *The Firebird*, Bronze Idol in *La Bayadere* and the Prince in *The Nutcracker*. Arkadiy spent the last four years with Houston Ballet and was director of the Vaganova Program at Houston International Ballet Academy. He is currently director of the Toledo Ballet.
